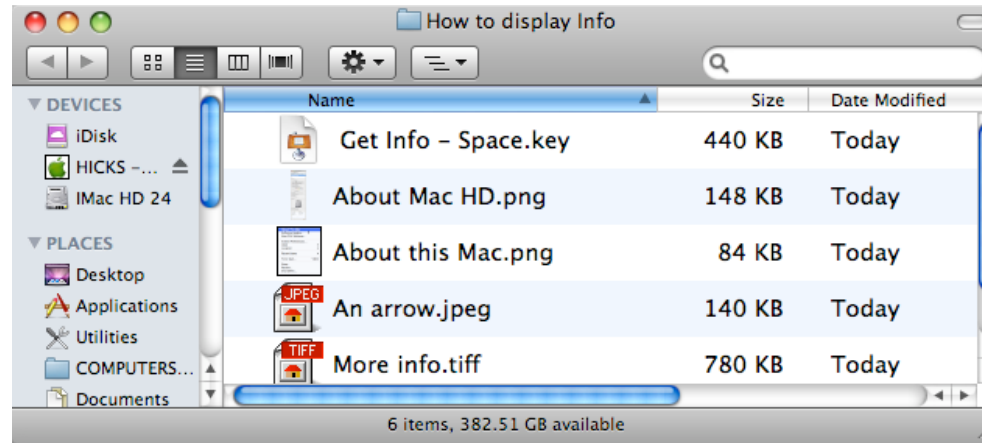


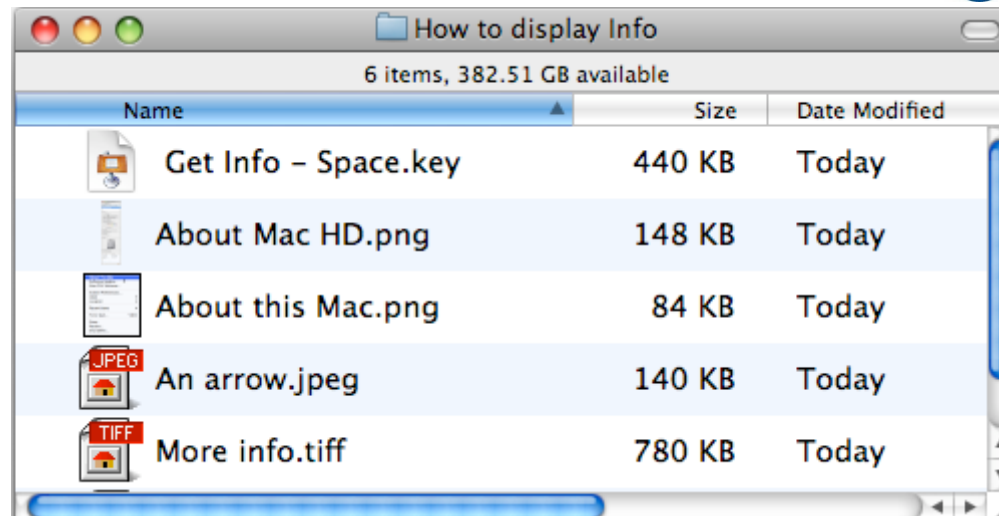
How to Determine the Remaining **Space available on any Hard Disk or any other Disk or “Volume”** do one of the following steps

Method # 1. It is always shown at the bottom a “fully displayed” Finder Window.



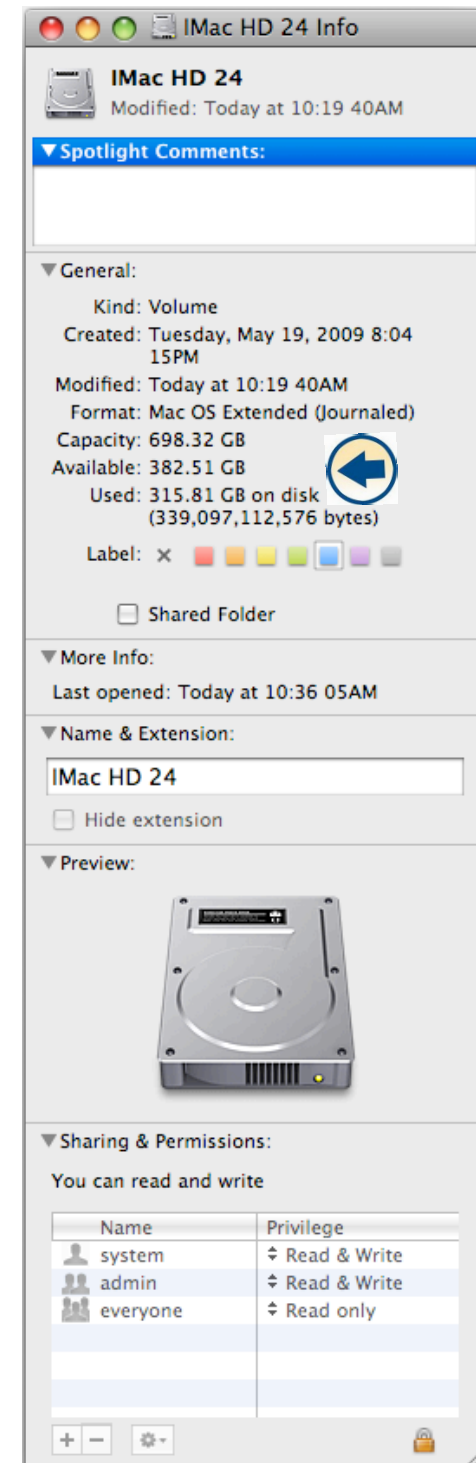
However, it is not shown if the “Sidebar” is not displayed in the Finder Window.

So, if the Sidebar is not displayed, You may Click this “Oval” to view the full Finder Window, as shown above.




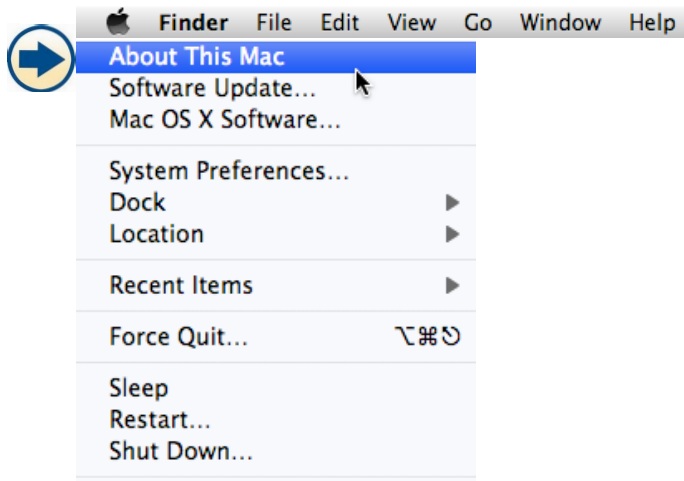
**Method #2. To display the space available on any “volume,”
Select the volume in the Finder, the press the command key and
type the letter “I” to display the “Get Info” Window.**

A Window will open displaying the information.



Method #3

(a) To display the detailed information about space used or available on any “volume” - From the Apple Menu,  Select About This Mac -



(b) Then select More Info



(c) A “Detailed Description” of the computer, and all of it’s components will be displayed. For the primary hard disk, select Serial-ATA and a display will provide the information about the “Hard Drive.
