

Expanding Printing Options for Mac

It has well been over a year since Apple first shipped OS X 10.5 "Leopard." Its is now in it's fifth retail version. Many people have complained about Leopard's truncated printer controls. Some newer users haven't even discovered that the printing options in 10.5 are hidden behind that unlabeled blue arrow, in the unexpanded Print Controls Window.

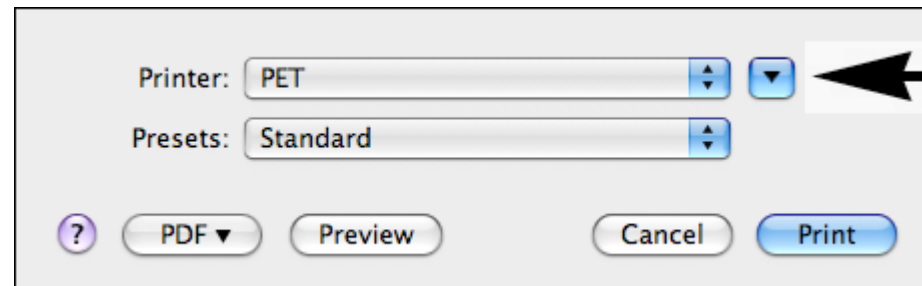
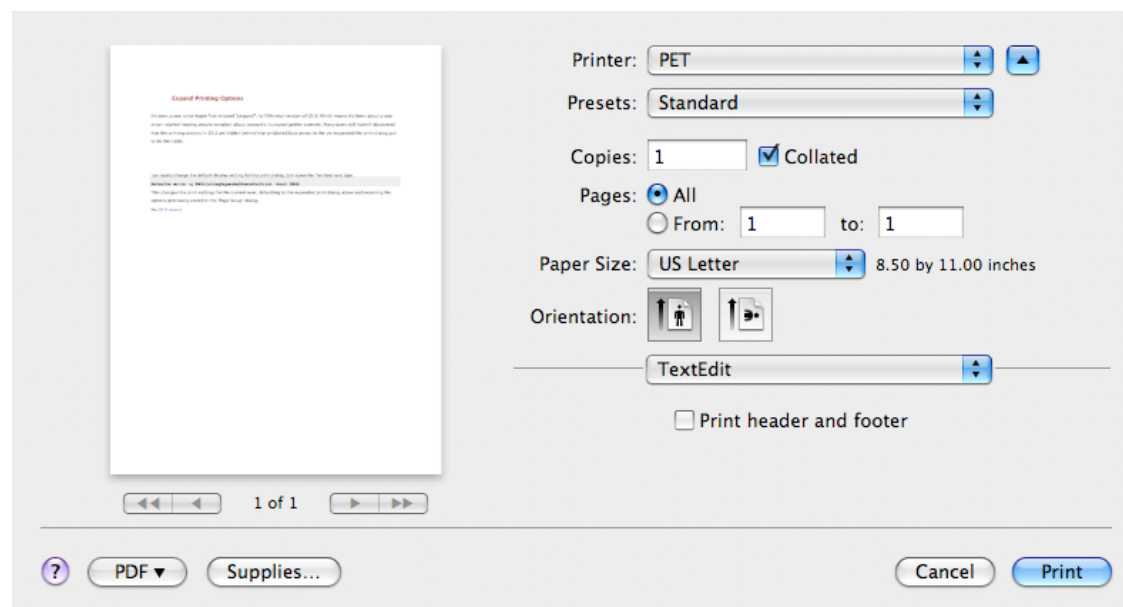


Figure 2 - The Expanded Printer Controls Dialog Box

The next time that you encounter the small print dialog box as shown **Figure 1**. Click on the large blue arrow to open the complete Print Controls Window as shown in **Figure 2**.

Figure 1 - Un-expanded Printer Controls

You may have to repeat this process for each of your installed applications. However, once you have used the expanded Printer Controls Window in an Apple Application, it should open properly each time you print from that application.
