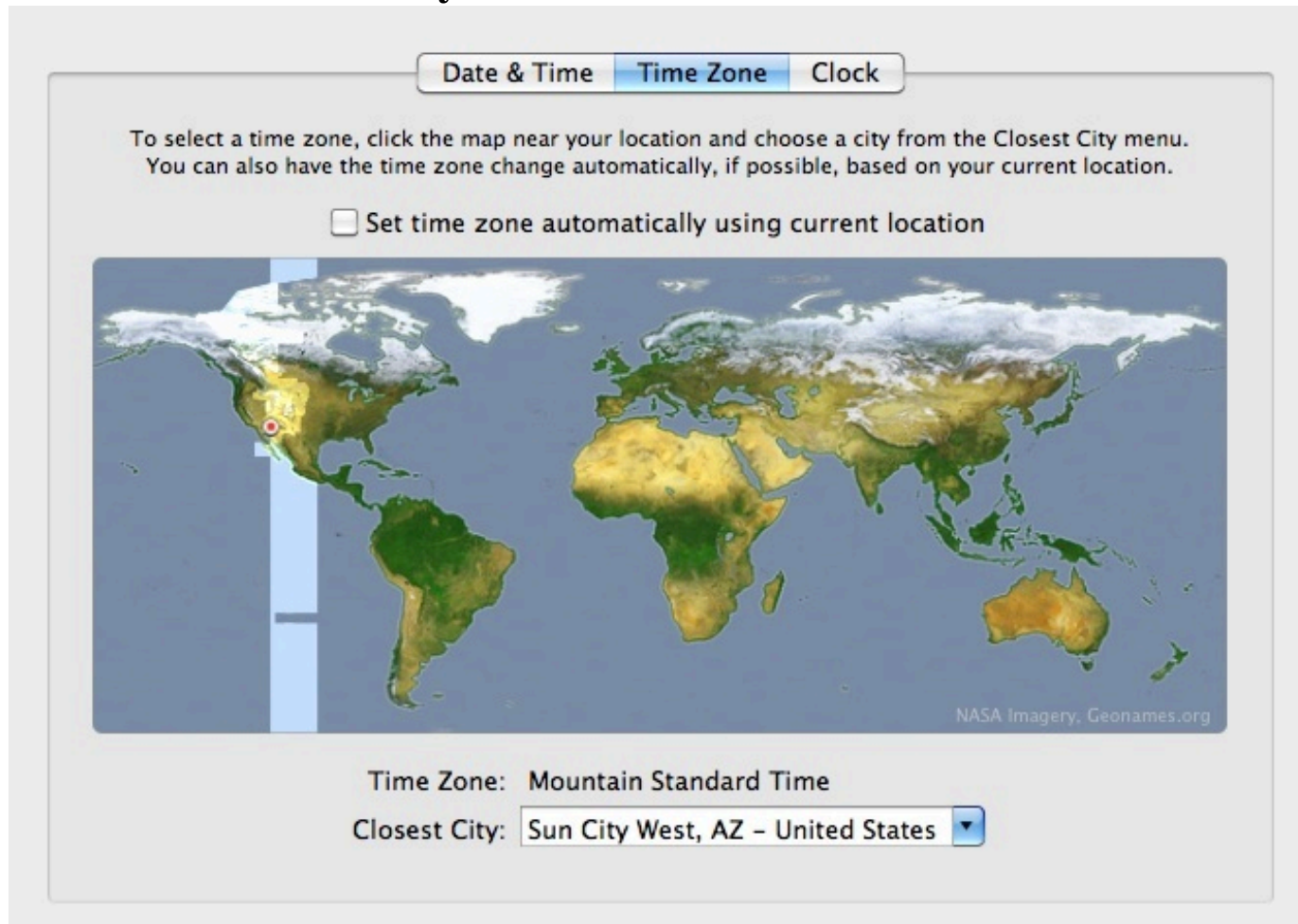
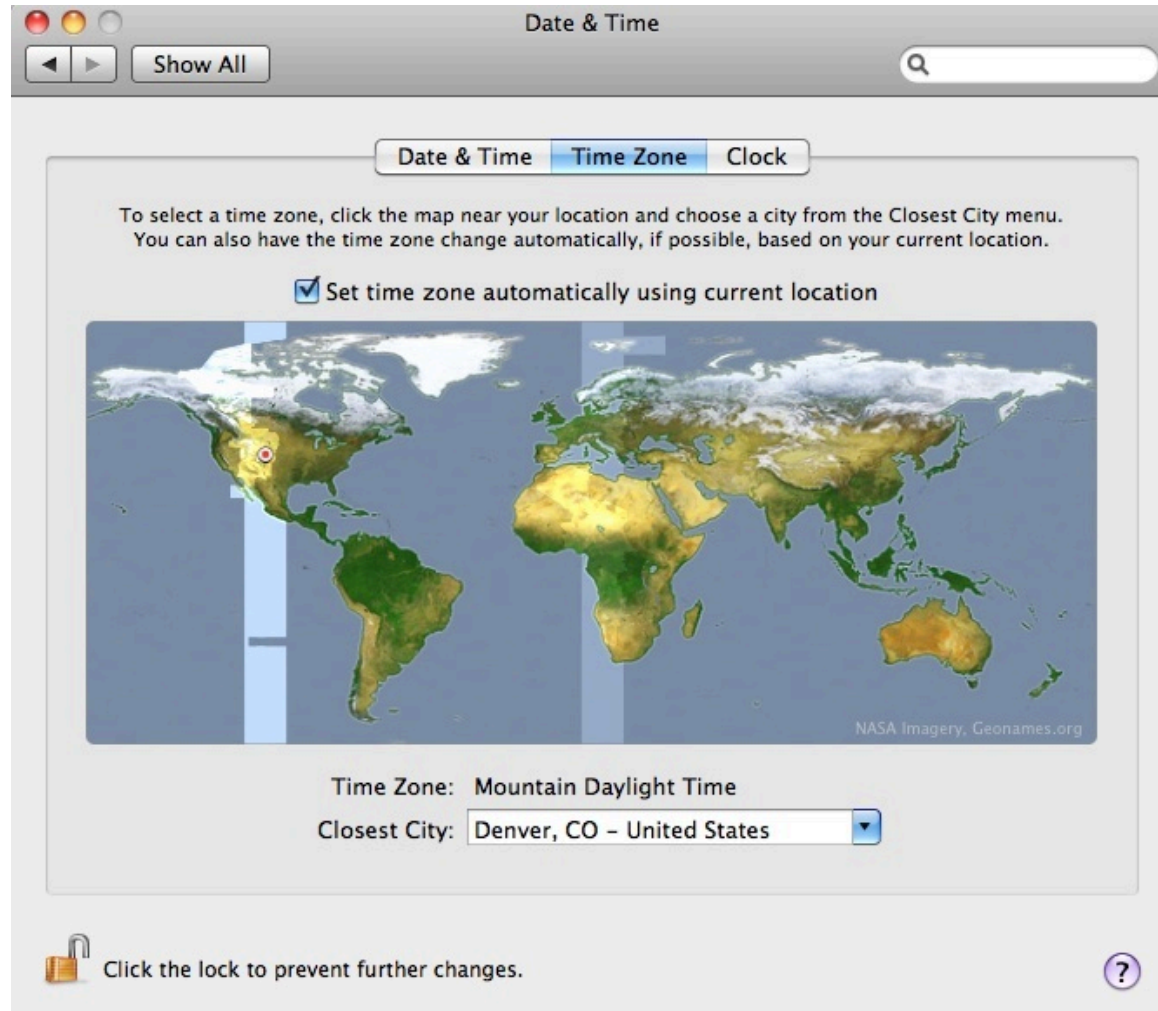


## If You Want the Mac to Display the Time Relative to Where You Are To Manually Set the Location and Time Zone



One way is to go to the Apple Menu and Select System Preferences. Click on the Date & Time item. Then type in the name of the “Closest City” as shown in Figure 1. The relative location is immediately displayed on the Map. The local Time Zone is also automatically displayed.

### **Time Zone Settings are Relative to Where You Are**

Automatically set the time zone you happen to be in. In the Date And Time preference in System Preferences place a ✓ "Set time zone automatically using current location." Now, the Time displayed will be correct where ever you are. This is great if you travel with your Mac.
